

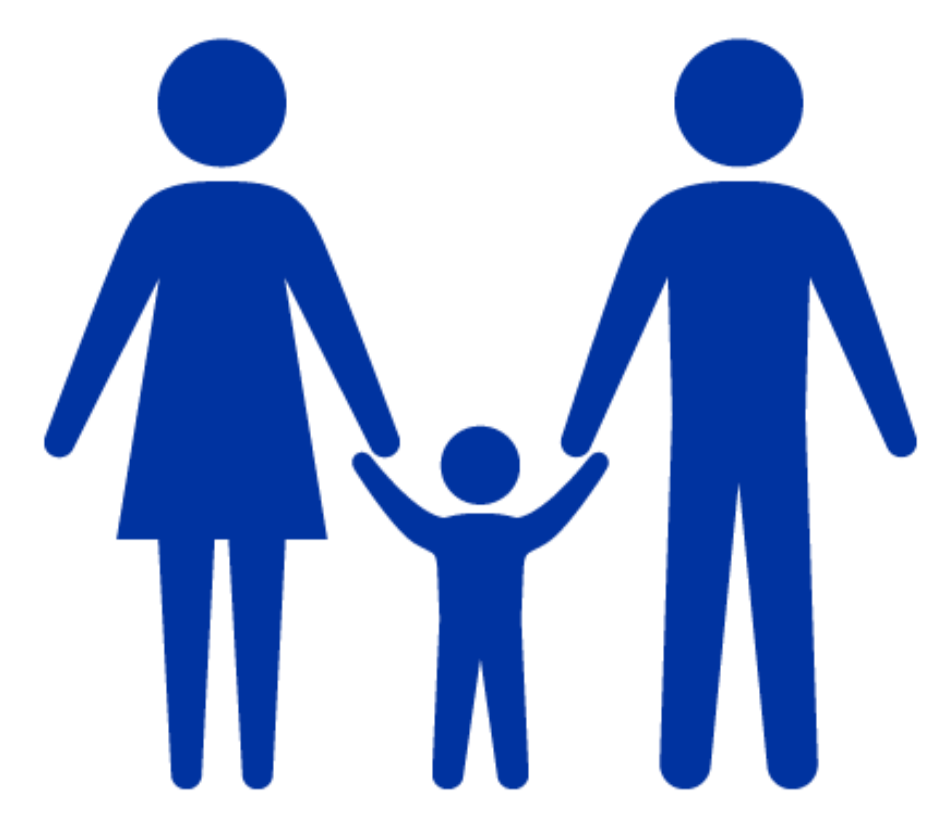

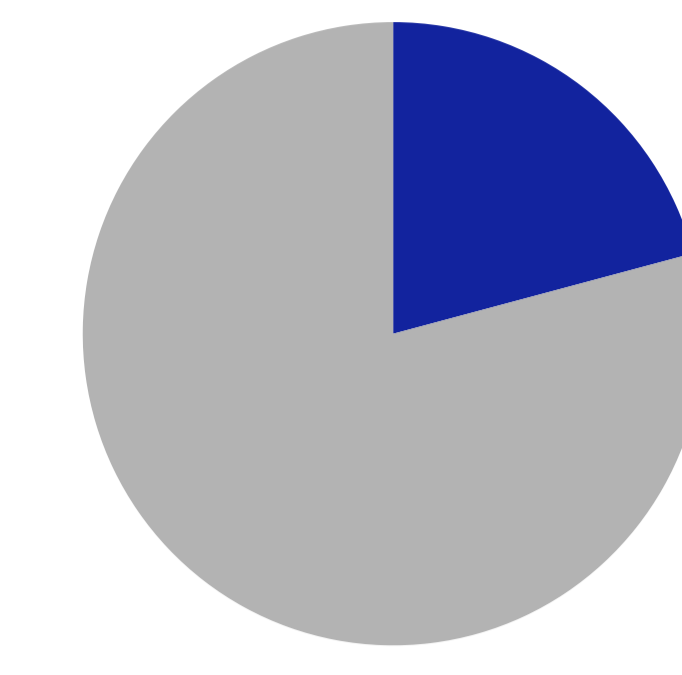
# Quarterly Resettlement and Humanitarian Admission Statistics for the European Economic Area Jan - Sep 2020 (Quarter 1,2,3)\*

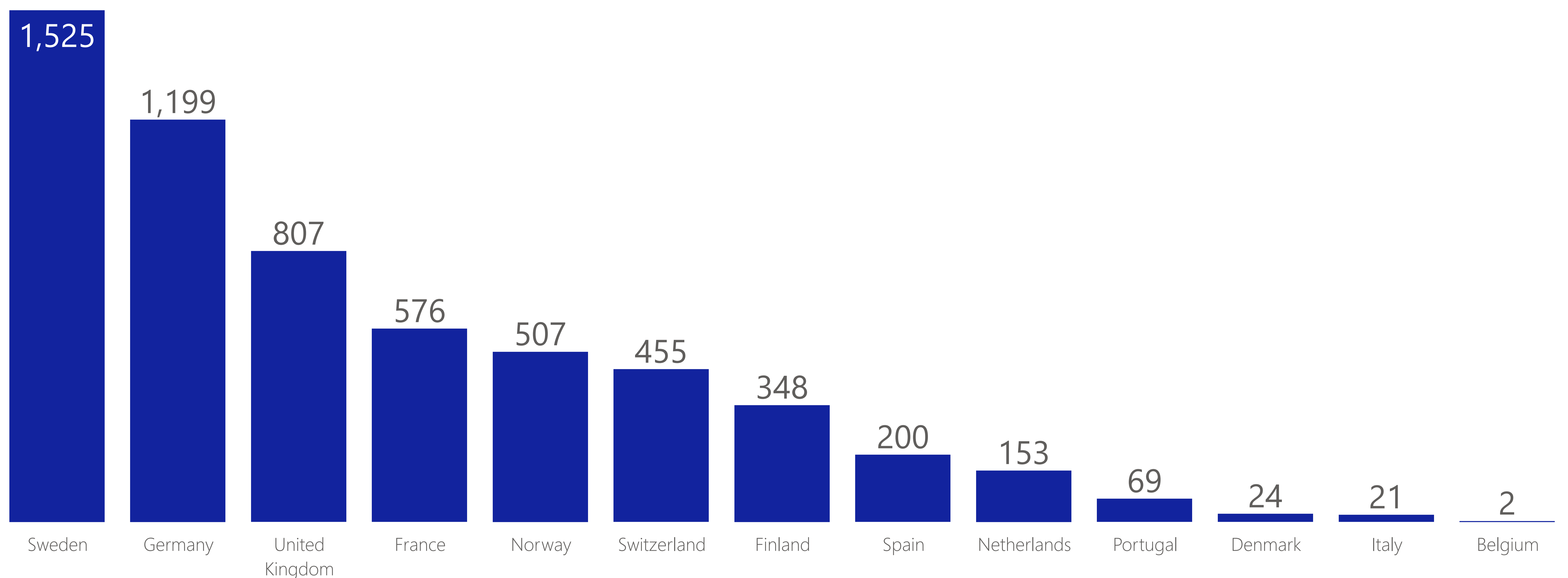

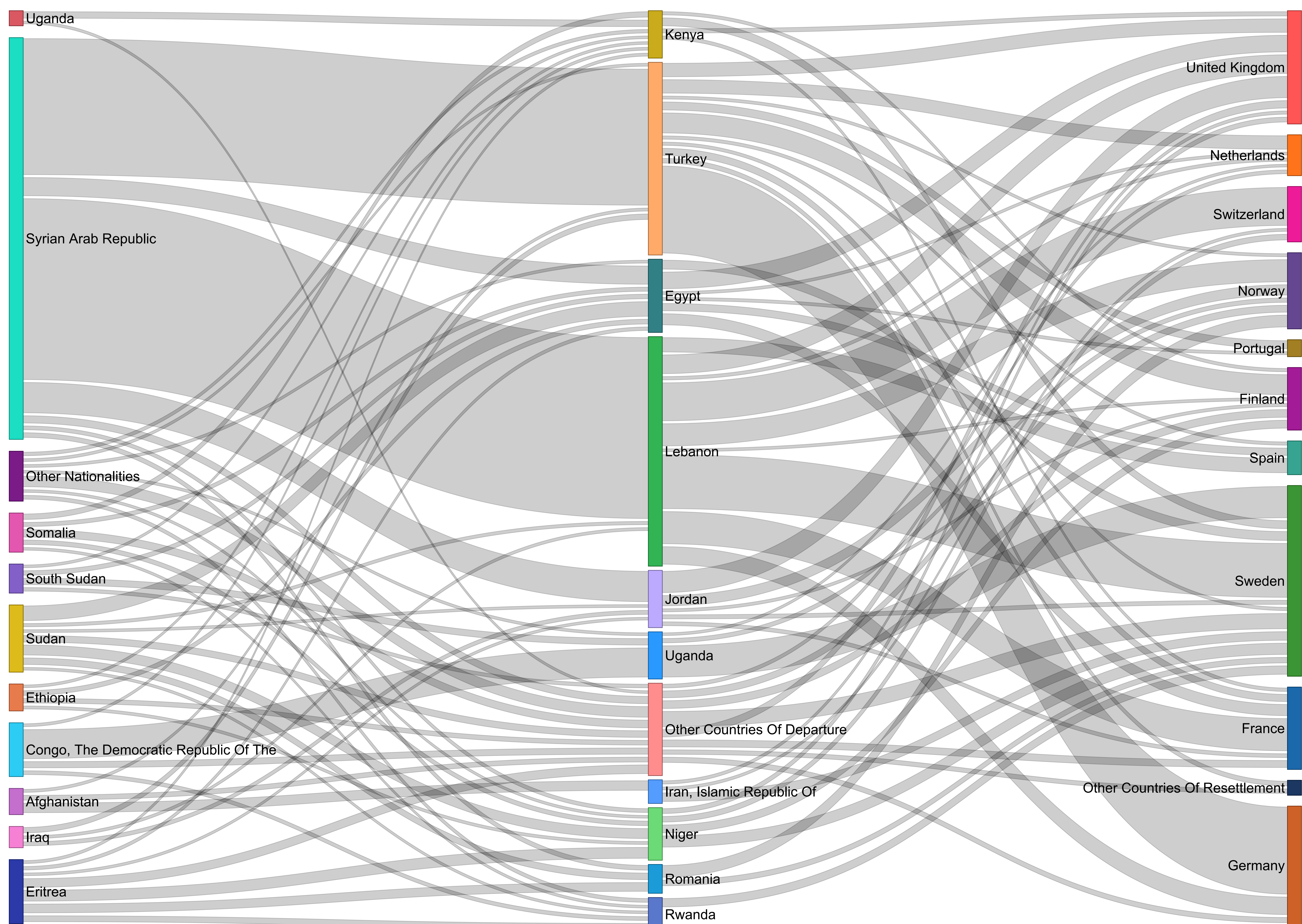

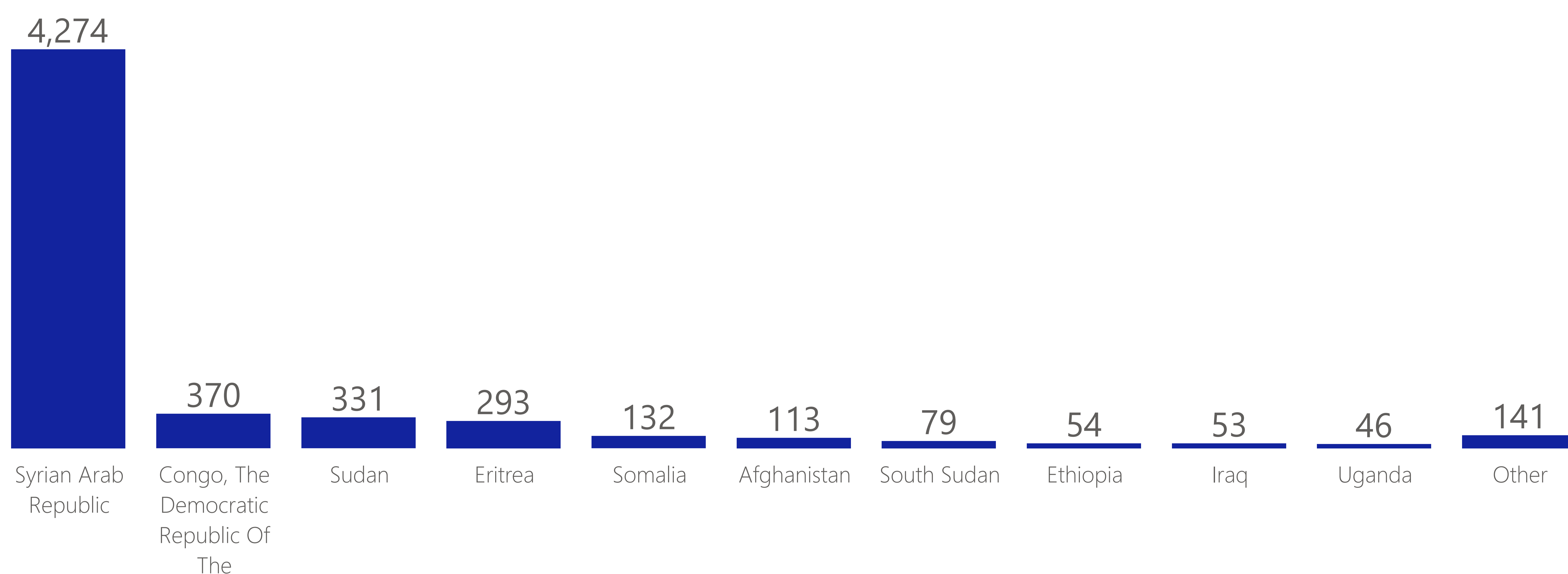

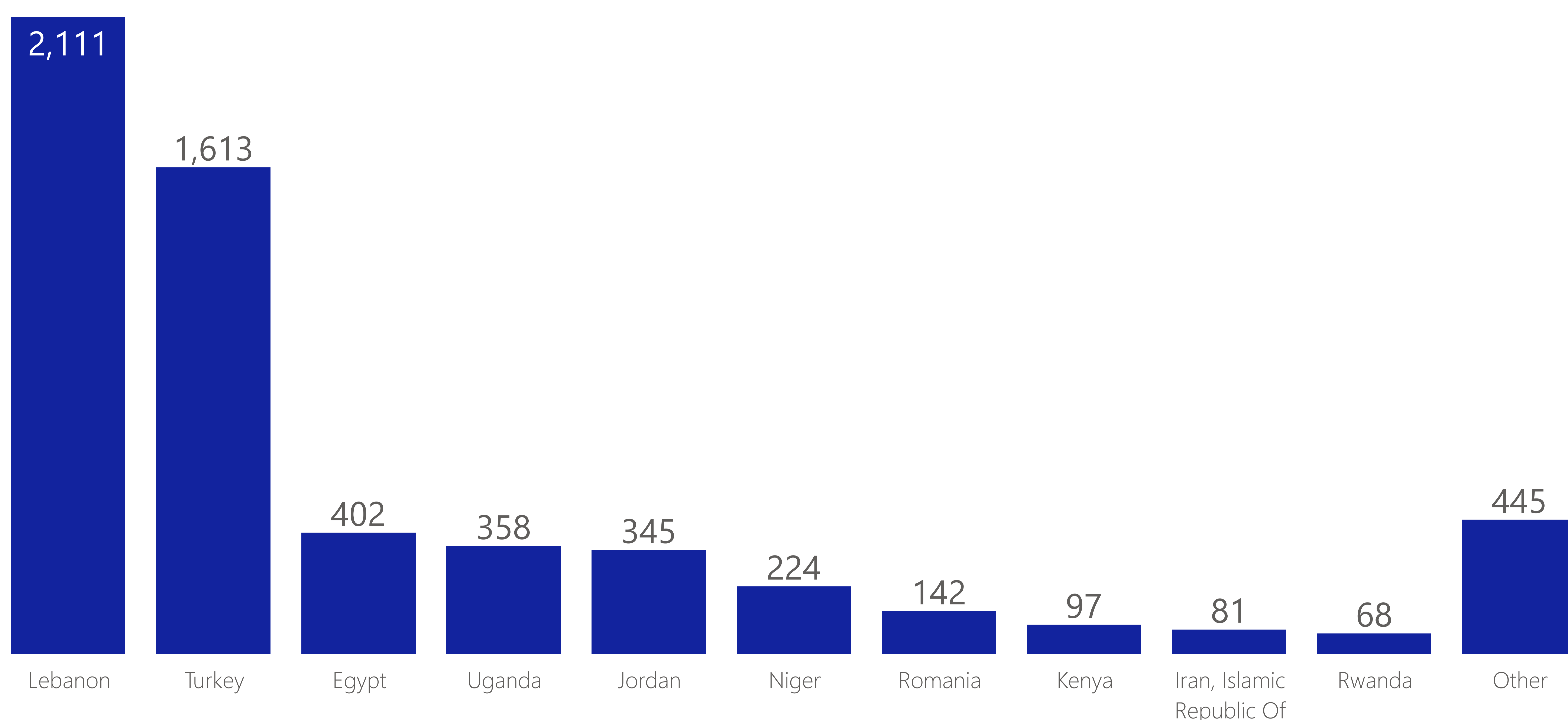
### Nationalities of Beneficiaries Assisted with Resettlement or Humanitarian Admission

Jan - Sep 2020



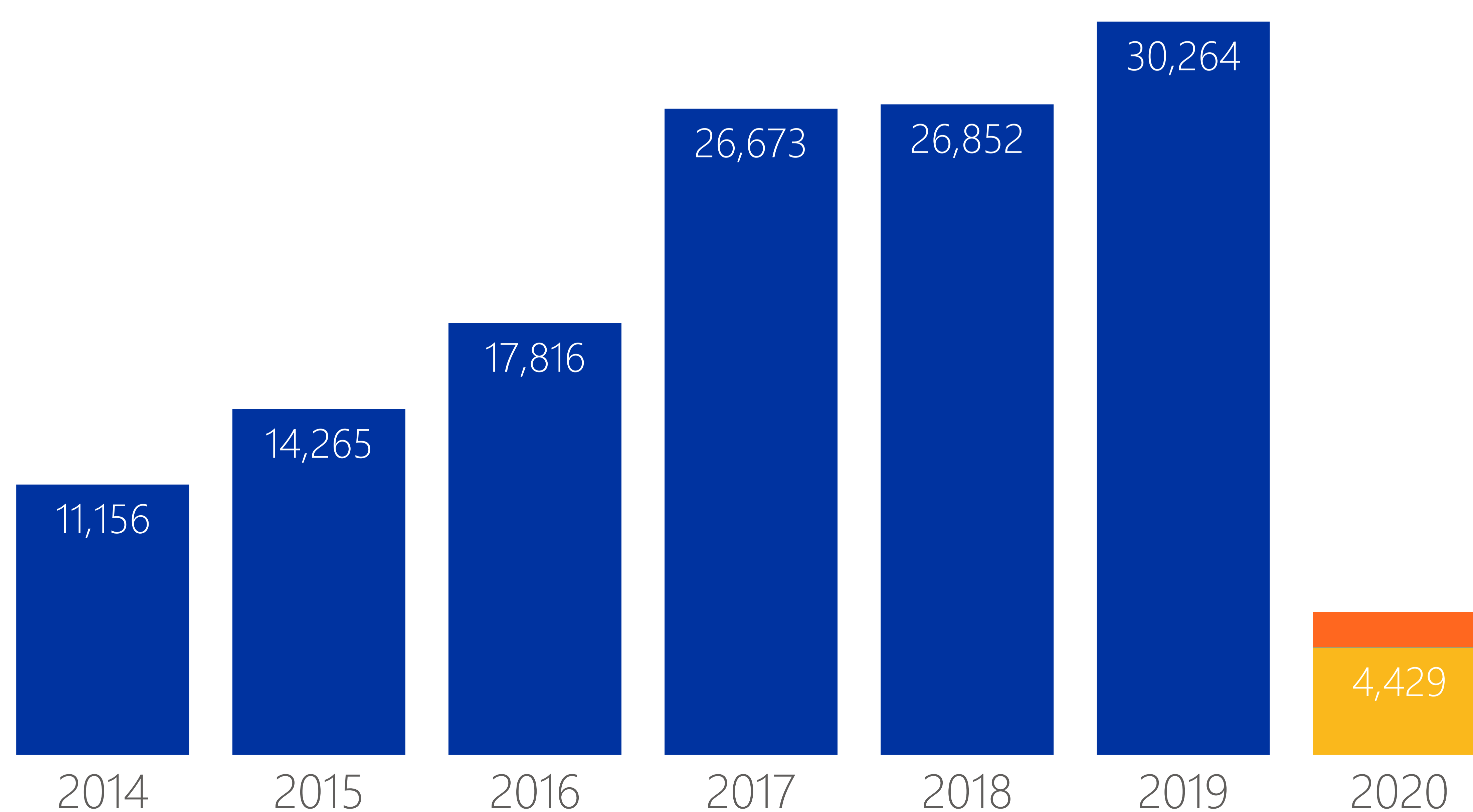
### Countries of Departure of Beneficiaries Assisted with Resettlement or Humanitarian Admission

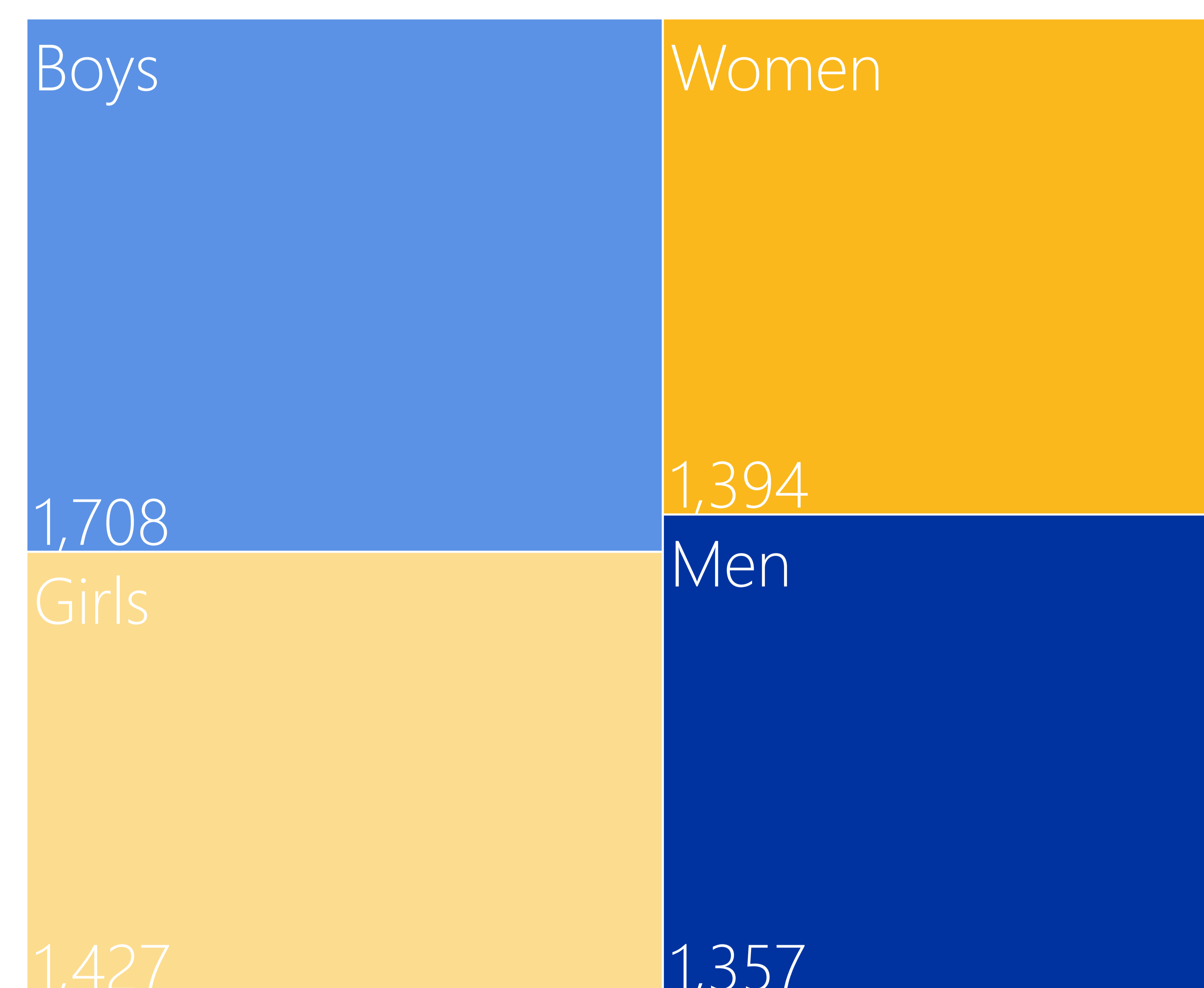
### EEA Resettlement and HAP Assistance over Time
